

The best Spanish films will be screened in Miami from 21 to 23 November

'Three more weddings', '10, 000 Km', 'Betubú', 'The great Spanish family' and 'Life Unexpected', selected for the fourth edition of 'Recent Cinema from Spain'.

EGEDA (management rights of audiovisual producers) and the Olympia Theatre Gusman Center in Miami, in collaboration with ICAA (Institute of Cinematography and Audiovisual Arts of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports of Spain) have announced five titles to be showcased at the fourth edition of the exhibition *Recent Cinema from Spain*, To be held from 20 to 23 November in Miami.

The selected films are: *3 weddings more* By Javier Ruiz Caldera; *10,000 km*, Carlos Marques-Marcet; *Betibú* By Miguel Cohan; *The large Spanish family* Daniel Sánchez Arevalo; there *Unexpected life* By Jorge Torregrossa.

Following the great success of the previous editions, which attracted an attendance of nearly 4,000 people each year, the Recent Cinema from Spain returns to Miami (Florida) for the fourth time with the most vibrant and representative films of more recent Spanish film, to be shown in the big screen Olympia Theatre, located in the heart of Downtown Miami.

Attendees will enjoy daily releases and participate in discussions with actors and guest conductors. The show will begin with a gala opening on 20 November, the inaugural screening of the film and a subsequent reception.

The names of the guests and the title of the film that closed the four days of film, will be released in mid-November.
